Bangladesh has the highest rate of child marriage. As mentioned before, below the age of 18 is childhood according to UN definition. Child marriage does not help the women grow and develop with maturity and culture, which is not conducive to their public voice and women empowerment. The customs and culture of the developing world including Bangladesh do not permit the women doing things and lead the life on their own. This not positive for the women empowerment. In Muslim culture, it is normally assumed that these are man-dominated society. Men do not prefer their women to take the leadership in family-and social life.
